Schedule 2009/2010

1. Three-month course

Intensive course : 21 hours of class per week with 15 hours of general French (oral and written), 2 hours of phonetics (half class), 3 hours of optional courses and 1 hour of tutoring. Electives include: linguistic support, French culture and literature or specialist French. The general French classes are designed for a maximum of 15 students.

Quarter 4 (autumn): Monday 5 October – Friday 18 December 2009
 Quarter 1 (winter): Wednesday 6 January – Friday 26 March 2010
 Quarter 2 (spring): Tuesday 6 April – Friday 25 June 2010

2. Three- and four-week courses

Intensive course: 21 hours of class per week with 15 hours of general French (oral and written), 2 hours of phonetics (half class), 3 hours of optional courses and 1 hour of tutoring. Elective courses include: linguistic support, French culture and literature or specialist French. The general French classes are designed for a maximum of 15 students.

All courses start on Monday, once a month, except in January and April 2010.
 The course can be followed for 2 weeks between October and May (in summer, see 3.)
 In June and September, a 5-week course is available.

3. One or two-week course

1- or 2- week French language improvement courses:

- Extensive course, with 15 hours per week (morning classes Monday to Friday)

- Intensive course, with 20 hours per week (15 hours of morning class and 5 hours of conversation class in the afternoon).

Small groups of 6 to 10 students per class.

Starting dates: every Monday from 31 May until 13 September 2010

4. Training for teachers of French

Training for teachers of French: 90 hours of course and workshops during 4 weeks. The course can be attended for 2 weeks only.

Four-week course

July: Monday 5 July – Friday 30 July 2010

August: Monday 2 August – Friday 27 August 2010

Two-week course

July – 1st half: Monday 5 – Friday 16 July 2010

July – 2nd half: Monday 19 July – Friday 30 July 2010

August – 1st half: Monday 2 August – Friday 13 August 2010

August – 2nd half: Monday 16 August – Friday 27 August 2010

General information
